**MINUTES OF 60<sup>TH</sup> MIDH MEETING HELD ON DATED 16.04.2020 AT 10:00 AM THROUGH VC (VIDYOMOBILE APP) UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF DR. B.S. SEHRAWAT, MISSION DIRECTOR, HSHDA, HARYANA, PANCHKULA.**

The meeting was started by welcoming all the members. The agenda was discussed and actions taken are as under:-

**Agenda No. 1: Confirmation of the proceedings of 59<sup>th</sup> MIDH meeting.**

The minutes of 59<sup>th</sup> MIDH meeting which was held on dated 09.03.2020 were circulated vide memo no.10043-72/Hort-APO/NHM/5/XI/IV dated 09.03.2020 to all concerned. As no comments were received from any quarter, so the minutes of 59<sup>th</sup> meeting were confirmed.

**Agenda No. 2: Action Taken Report of previous meetings.**

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**Agenda No. 3: Review of Component-wise progress up to date.**

MD reviewed the Component-wise Physical & Financial achievements under MIDH scheme. The financial achievement for the year 2019-20 has been recorded with an expenditure of Rs. 11284.47lakhs out of total approved outlay of Rs. 15616.65 lakhs which is approx. 72.26% achievement (including committed liabilities). However the financial achievement as per the available funds is 100%.

MS, DHMIU Bhiwani was directed to draw soil and water samples from the site of proposed CoE, Gignow, Bhiwani.

Some MS, DHMIUs raised the issue regarding non-disbursement of the assistance on some activities/ components who were completed by the farmers some of them have also been uploaded on the portal for assistance. It was informed by MD that the II<sup>nd</sup> Instalment amounting Rs. 2667.00 lakhs for the year 2019-20 was not released by FD. As and when it will be released by FD, assistance will be provided to the concern beneficiaries.

**Agenda No. 4: Status of additional assistance of 15% as State Share for protected structures during 2019-20.**

The additional assistance of 15% as State Share for protected structures was reviewed by MD. A total of Rs. 10.16 crore has been utilized for the year 2019-20. All MS, DHMIUs were directed to send the details of final inspection of protected structures so that PSE-II so that he could be deputed for the same as ADC-cum-Chairman are busy in administrative work due to coronavirus.

**Agenda No. 5: Review of progress of SCSP component under MIDH scheme up to date.**

It was intimated that the report of SCSP component under MIDH for the year 2019-20 has been received from all the quarter. The achievements of District Bhiwani, Jhajjar, Kurukshetra, Mewat, Palwal, Sirsa and Sonipat were found very low. MD directed EO to call explanation of low achieving districts and report within a fortnight accordingly.

**Agenda No. 6: Target & achievements of DBT under MIDH for 2019-20.**

The physical targets & achievement of beneficiaries covered under MIDH through DBT during 2019-20 was reviewed by MD. 21636 beneficiaries has availed subsidy against a target of 24500 under the scheme i.e. 88.31%.

**Agenda No. 7: Discussion of Annual Action Plan for the year 2020-21.**

MS, DHMIUs have submitted the tentative allocation to be made in their respective district amounting to Rs. 200 crores for the year 2020-21 under MIDH. The proposal was discussed in SLEC and has been approved. The same may be forwarded to GOI for further administrative approval.

**Agenda No.-8: Procurement of Horticulture produces during lockdown.**

In view of spread of Covid19 virus across the country the following Officers has been designated to keep track on the production, procurement, supply and transportation of Horticulture produce in the state:

1. Sh. R. S. Taya, Mushroom Expert has been designated as State level Nodal Officer for Mushroom/Pathological related issues.
2. MS, DHMIU Palwal will monitor the activities related to floriculture in the state.
3. MS, DHMIU Karnal and DHC Karnal will keep track on the activities related to Vegetable production/supply/transportation in the state.
4. HC-I and ABM will be responsible for activities related to PHM & Marketing Infrastructure.

5. MS, DHMIU Sirsa has been designated to monitor the activities related to Fruits and MS, DHMIU Hisar will keep track of strawberry produce in the state.
