# During review of Action taken report the following decisions were taken:

3.1 MD instructed all MS, DHMIUs & DHCs to send registered notice to all farmers for insurance of their protected structure. Final installment of the structure shall not be released if the structure is damaged. It was also instructed to visit the damaged structure and report within 7 days.

3.2 It was decided in the house that meeting of protected cultivation structure insurance firm be called.

3.3 Under MIDH for the year 2016-17, it was decided by the house that the hybrid vegetables i.e. tomato, cauliflower, onion, chilly, capsicum & broccoli shall be grown in open fields & high value crops i.e. cucumber, tomato & capsicum in protected structures under MIDH. In this regard, detailed instructions shall be circulated later on.

3.4 All MS, DHMIUs were instructed to submit the success stories of 3 to 5 horticulture beneficiaries under MIDH scheme of their district within a week.

District Horticulture Consultant from District Panipat, Jind & Jhajjar gave brief power point presentation on protected cultivation structure about damaged structures due to heavy wind. MD, instructed that all DHCs will visit and cover all the damaged structures & report immediately to concern MS, DHMIU & at HQ within a week. PSE-II was directed to prepare the list of damaged structures due to high wind speed, so that Govt. could be informed accordingly.

MD instructed all MS, DHMIUs to make liaisoning with construction firms, insurance companies & farmers for repairing of such damaged structures & to settle the claims at the earliest.
